Stakeholder Workshops Scheduled for January 2016 in Three Locations

The Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council, in partnership with East Central Florida Regional Planning Council, received a Florida Department of Economic Opportunity Technical Assistance Grant Program to develop an Urban-Rural Design Overlay and conduct an opportunities inventory for the Florida Coast to Coast Connector (C2C or "Connector").

The Connector is a significant cross-state trail in the statewide network of Greenways and Trails, spanning from the Gulf of Mexico to the Atlantic Ocean and traversing nine counties. This multijurisdictional, multi-agency effort is aimed at closing seven trail gaps across the state to create the "Connector." C2C will be Florida's first cross-state paved trail. The Connector will span approximately 250 miles when completed. Currently, the C2C is nearly 75 percent complete. This trail will provide Floridians and visitors with a unique trail experience, both through natural Florida as well as through downtowns and other destinations.
